Bart Currie is Head of Infectious Diseases at Royal Darwin Hospital and Professor in Medicine at the Northern Territory Medical Program, Flinders and Charles Darwin Universities. He is also Program Leader for Tropical and Emerging Infectious Diseases in the Global and Tropical Health Division of the Menzies School of Health Research and Director of RHD Australia. Areas of interest include clinical and epidemiological aspects of tropical and emerging infections, development of treatment guidelines and clinical toxinology. He initiated the Darwin Prospective Melioidosis Study in 1989 and this remains the basis for ongoing multi-disciplinary collaborations on melioidosis.
