

## Janet Eyre

Professor Janet Eyre is Professor of Paediatric Neuroscience at Newcastle University in the UK. A previous Rhodes Scholar and Wellcome Senior Fellow in Clinical Science, she is an internationally recognised expert in brain plasticity following brain injury across the life span and its implications for rehabilitation. She currently leads a research program of £2.7 million into the clinical application of video games for online physiotherapy, enabling home-based-delivery of therapy with expert remote monitoring and management by therapists.
