

## Shane Stenhouse

Shayne Stenhouse has very recently been appointed to the role of Telehealth Business Coordinator, Darling Downs Hospital and Health Service. Shayne had previously been Telehealth Facilitator for Central and Southern Queensland for a period of four years and prior to that a Business manager for Toowoomba Health Service District. Shayne has co authored two papers: "The Practical Issues in Using Existing Digital Stethoscopes in Telehealth" and "The establishment of a Sustainable Telehealth Service for Preadmission Clinic Consultations". The latter he presented at the 2009 IARIA Telemedicine conference in Cancun Mexico. Shayne has been made an Adjunct Associate Professor Business and Law at the University of Southern Queensland, for his close working relationship with the faculty in developing a digital stethoscope that is compatible with Queensland Health's Telehealth platform, and from mentoring students doing various research papers. Some Telehealth projects that Shayne has managed are: ICU ward rounds Bundaberg To Royal Brisbane and Women's Hospital(RBWH), Preadmission Clinics from 20 Rural sites to Toowoomba Hospital, Inflammatory Bowel Disease from RBWH to Rockhampton and Bundaberg. His current Telehealth projects include Oral Health, Interpreter Services and inpatient Telehealth within Darling Downs Hospital and Health Service.
