Poster Guidelines

Content and format

The poster should be a creative and visual presentation of the topics and/or methods outlined in the abstract. (It can include photos, illustrations, coloured fonts etc.)

The poster should be A1 in size (594mm x 841mm).

The submitted abstract represents a 'synopsis' of the poster display and will be published in both the Conference Handbook and Conference Proceedings.

In addition, if possible, a digital image of the poster (eg pdf or jpg) should be provided for publication in Conference Proceedings.

Poster process

Please do not send your poster to the National Rural Health Alliance prior to the Conference.

Set up for the posters is 24 May 2015 from 2pm. If you are unable to attend at this time for set-up you should make arrangements with a friend or colleague to deliver and display your poster. You will need to bring your own mounting materials (velcro dots are suitable for most posters). If you need any assistance please do not hesitate to approach Alliance staff at the Registration Desk who will gladly help - especially Janine if she's there.

Posters will be on display in the Exhibition Hall where delegates will be able to view them during breaks, the Welcome Reception and Exhibition Happy Hour. The author is encouraged to be available at these times to discuss their poster's content with viewers.

Posters can be removed on Wednesday 27 May 2015 after 1.00pm. Uncollected posters will be discarded. Poster presenters should take their posters with them when they leave or arrange for someone else to remove them.
