Genevieve has a long term interest in improving eye care access for communities in need and through her work at the Australian College of Optometry participates in clinical education of optometry students, mentoring of new graduate optometrists and providing specialist services in ocular diseases and low vision. The role of Lead Optometrist Aboriginal Services involves clinical service provision at Aboriginal health services and coordinating a team of optometrists providing services at 20 Aboriginal community controlled health services around Victoria. Genevieve also contributes to national and state policy and service developments in Aboriginal eye care through participation in the Vision 2020 Australia Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander committee and the Optometry Australia Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Eye Health Working Group. These groups enable collaboration with a range of key local and national stakeholders.
