Ruby has been involved with improving health services, including education and knowledge of nutrition among the elderly. She helped establish aged care hostels in several communities in the Top End. Ruby currently sits on the board of Wurli-Wurlinjang Health Service, and the North Australian Aboriginal Justice Agency. She continues giving back to the community by working towards improving the lives of Aboriginal people for a better future.
