



OUR COURSES AND PROGRAMS

Course in Ear and Hearing Health

1-day course

Presents knowledge to allow successful students to provide management strategies and understand referral pathways for specialist care, in relation to a range of conditions, based on detailed understanding of the anatomy, physiology and pathophysiology of the auditory system. Specialist skills include: point of care hearing assessment, otoscopy and wax removal.

Wound Closure

2-day course

Designed to develop the knowledge and skills required for Nurses, General Practitioners and relevant Allied Healthcare Workers to safely assess the need for and to perform wound closure in a variety of settings, employing a range of methods.

Graduate Certificate in ECG Interpretation

Distance-based online course

This post-graduate qualification is designed to give students a high level of knowledge and skills in ECG interpretation and critical rhythm recognition.

The programs below are fully-funded by the federal Department of Health, for professionals working in Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander health.

Otitis Media Management Program

1-day program

This program focusses on ear health assessment and otoscopy. It provides the skills and knowledge to safely assess and manage ear health in relation to a range of conditions, specifically otitis media, based on detailed knowledge of the anatomy, physiology and pathophysiology of the auditory system.

Chronic Disease Support Program

1-day program

Explores a range of topics including assessing risk factors, readiness for change and health behaviours, while working with both the client and their health professionals, to develop a chronic disease self-management plan.

Foot Health Assessment Program

1-day program

Explores how to perform a basic foot care assessment, determine foot care requirements and use basic equipment and topical medications where the services of a professional podiatrist are not required.

Nutrition Support Program

1-day program

Offers skills and knowledge to provide detailed information and advice concerning nutrition and dietary management, and learn appropriate strategies to monitor a client's response to information and education and comply with the instructions of the Dietitian.

Promoting Participation in the National Cervical Screening Program to Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander Women

Half-day program

Educates healthcare providers on the changes to the National Cervical Screening Program and promotes the benefits of regular cervical screening to Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander women.
